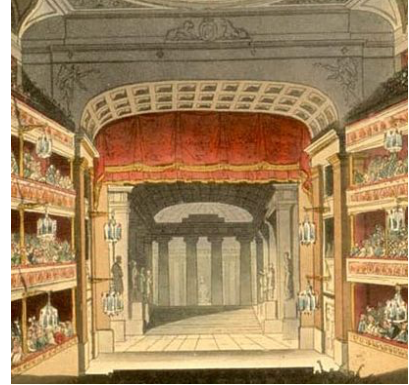


## MAKING MAGIC WITH TOY THEATER

Create your own performing world in a box! Toy theater explores the possibilities of a world where everything can come to life: characters, scenery, and even the stage itself.

In six, 2-hour sessions you will design and devise your own toy theater puppet show. We will learn tricks and techniques common in toy theater, but also take inspiration from the visual storytelling tools of scenography, comics, and cinema. The course focuses on how to create. How to begin and how to continue! Short readings and online viewings are assigned between classes to accompany your puppet theater progress.



Classes take place over ZOOM on Sunday and Thursday evenings from 6:30-8:30pm starting Thursday Aug 6. Class dates are: Aug 6th, 9th, 13th, 16th, 20th, 23rd

**SUPPLIES:** All theaters and puppets can be built from cardboard boxes. A single bike box is great or several small boxes will work too. All students are encouraged to procure the listed items and are welcome to work with further materials as they wish.

- Utility Knife (or snap blade or xacto....)
- Hot Glue Gun
- Duct Tape
- Black and Silver Sharpie Markers
